- China eighth amendment to Criminal Law, criminalising bribery of foreign officials



Corporate anti-corruption policies, procedures and transparency commitments:

- E.g. Country by country reporting

Promote integrity across their broader sphere of influence:

 E.g. Assess bribery and corruption risks across a company's entire supply chain

RECOMMENDATIONS TO GOVERNMENTS

Strengthen existing legislation

– E.g. prohibit facilitation payments

Step up the enforcement of existing laws.

 E.g. All countries, including Germany, Japan and Saudi Arabia, must ratify the UN Convention on Anti-Corruption.
